












«Mémoire et Insomnie du Regard»

Vincent Ceraudo explore d'autres niveaux perceptifs et notre dimension irrationnelle à travers l'expérience des limites du corps, l'architecture postmoderne, les médiums ou le point de vue des drones. Un spectre hante les expositions actuelles : le tournage réalisé avec des drones. D'Adrien Missika à Cyprien Gaillard, ce mode d'enregistrement vidéo à la mécanicité robotique, semblable à un inquiétant œil de surveillance hors du monde, permet de dépasser les contraintes spatiales d'un tournage classique, tout en instaurant le doute sur la subjectivité du regard de l'artiste.

Y a-t-il encore un pilote derrière la caméra ? Vincent Ceraudo ne se rait pas contraire à cette absence tant son travail semble vouloir dépasser les limites de perception et d'intelligibilité humaines. Pourtant, plutôt que d'intelligence artificielle, il faudrait parler dans son travail de la réalité elle-même comme d'un arifice. Il suffit de regarder sa vidéo Paris City Ghost (2015), où une caméra-drone filme une tour Eiffel entourée d'immeubles haussmanniens étrangement neufs mais déjà abandonnés, au milieu de terrains vagues, pour constater le trouble.

Une ville dont le matériau est sa propre fiction, une réplique fantomatique construite dans la banlieue de la ville chinoise de Hangzhou, à plus de 10 000 kilomètres de son modèle. Cet intérêt pour les réalités flottantes, l'hypnose et autres aptitudes extrasensorielles, est d'ailleurs un trait commun aux recherches scientifiques de la fin du XIX siècle, et à l'usage de la photographie dès ses débuts (attestant de phénomènes occultes ou médiumniques).

Pour Vincent Ceraudo, ces phénomènes ne se situent pas dans un au-delà invisible, mais bien dans l'expérience même du corps. C'est via cette fascination pour les fantômes dans les machines, et dans cette imbrication de la conscience et de l'irrationalité, que l'artiste semble nous rappeler qu'il y a des territoires qui nous restent encore inconnus de nous, des phénomènes imperceptibles pour la science, qui logent notre intelligence et nos corps futurs.

On April 19, 2015, I went into the Gurbantunggut desert in the north west China. I traveled from the city of Urumuqi accompanied with a guide following an itinerary on 600 km, keeping the North East direction to arrive to the coordinates of the terrestrial pole of inaccessibility : 46°16'58,8 N.A 88° 7' 58,8 E. These coordinates corresponds to the most remote point of the oceans on earth. A trailer of the travel for the agency which financed my project and a series of photographs taken during the exploration constitute the form of this experience.

This video consist of a journey inside the rationalist architecture, and questions how fictional elements can become physical objects, through the exploration and apprehension of space.

Sun Surface combines documentary material with a staged science fiction narrative set in Ordos, a city in the Inner Mongolia part of China. Taking this specifically as a starting point while also considering China's rapid global ascent as an overarching context, the film interrogates questions of growth, energy, economics and fictions of technico-scientific progress as well as its aesthetic and socio-political dimensions in the time of the climate crisis. The film follows a small team of scientists that is sent to map out the area and its surroundings. Through an open-ended discussion about what is happening to time and space, they try to understand a strange scorching phenomenon coming from the surface of the sun.

A lifelong series, the words are use to define events (often not perceptible yet) related to our universe that may or may not come into being. These short haiku-like sentences, take shape in the imagination of whoever reads the words and so become an expression of the idea itself, whose form and scale transcended observability and physical limits. The projection of these words in the obscurity increase their cosmic dimension.

These are images seen in a dream or a memory, those that come to us immediately but are not so clear, and which I have reconstructed with AI. It's difficult to stick as closely as possible to the memory that remains (action, color, light, framing, settings). Generative AI works like a kind of collective unconscious in which the machine brings up (from the prompt) images, much like in the dream process. In dreams, there are also people who don't exist, or who can be a mix of two people we know. Memory recomposes fragments and consolidates a character or a scene, just like generative AI. The images generated by AI, like dream images, are puzzles, but their meaning would never be discovered. Printed on 35 mm negative film, I've then analogically develop and enlarge them to play with both the qualities and boundaries of photography. Using the emulsion and photographic process I've tried to creates images with a dark and ethereal quality, using light and shadow to evoke a sense of mystery. These «generated photographs» allowed me to obtain a dreamlike and cinematic quality that draws viewers into a surreal and introspective world.
